



Heading Home Junior Board Responsibilities October 2021

The Heading Home Junior Board is a select group of early to mid-career professionals whose mission is to engage the next generation of business and philanthropic leaders in Greater Boston with Heading Home by hosting events, raising awareness and providing direct financial and volunteer support to the organization.

Each Junior Board Committee Member makes Heading Home one of his or her top philanthropic priorities. As a group, the Junior Board's primary role is to act as ambassadors of the organization with a goal to increase community and financial support for the organization, as well as to spread awareness of Heading Home amongst fellow young professionals in greater Boston.

- Understand and promote Heading Home's mission
- Commit to serving a minimum of 2 years with bi-annual renewal commitment
- Make an annual personal gift to the agency to be completed by 6/30 annually (minimum \$250)
- Secure an annual give/get for the agency to be completed by 6/30 annually (minimum \$1,000)
- Reach into personal networks to cultivate and solicit new individuals to engage with Heading Home through donations, events, and volunteerism
- Attend at least 3 out of 5 meetings per year
- Attend at least 3 fundraising/volunteer events during the fiscal year. These events include Halloween parties, Thanksgiving dinners, Holiday events, landscaping days, Housewarming Event, Junior Board Up & Out.
- Attend Summer Fundraiser Event – This is a mandatory attendance event (June). ** This event should be seen as a main commitment of every council member and mandatory since it is our group held event. This will act as the essential and primary avenue for the Junior Board to raise awareness and critical funds for Heading Home. **
